Criteria for Application:

1. Applicants must have a hemophilia A or B diagnosis letter from an HTC or personal physician (must be on letterhead).
2. Applicants must be a U.S. citizen
3. Applicants may be endeavoring in any academic or career field of study.
4. Applicants must submit a current school academic transcript.
5. Applicants must have a current Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.0 or greater (applicant must also maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or better and satisfactory academic progress for scholarship award and/or renewal).
6. Applicants must submit a resume containing the applicant's academic and employment history.
7. Applicants must be entering or attending a college, university, junior college, or vocational school in the Fall of 2020.
8. Applicants must submit a 500 word or less essay titled: *My Academic and Career goals*.
9. Applicants must submit two (2) signed letters of recommendation (preferably on letterhead).
10. Scholarship award selection considerations include overall presentation and completeness of the application packet, recommendation letters, essay, academic performance, and community volunteer/ extracurricular activities.
